Meeting called to order by Dr. Chizmar at 9:35 AM.

Minutes March 2021. Passed as written.

Old Business:

Protocol 2.0: Dr. Chizmar further discussed the new protocol document format which is in its final review before publication. The document is expected to be available by the end of this month along with the protocol update video.

Crashing Patient: Tim Burns presented background. Extensive discussion was held about the proper placement in the protocol document if the proposal were to be adopted. Further discussion held about education vs. protocol.

The proposal was tabled for the July meeting after discussion about adding a checklist to the General Patient Care section vs. adding a second reference in the Treatment section.

Hydrofluoric acid: Dr. Levy presented background. Dr. Anders reported PEMAC reviewed the proposal and had recommendations but overall had a favorable review. Discussion was held whether calcium gluconate or chloride would be the form of choice. Decision was made to stay with chloride. Discussion was held about whether to have the

new protocol become part of the General patient Care section or the Optional Supplemental Protocols. Conclusion of the discussion held for the protocol to go to the Optional Section.

Proposal adopted as amended.

Acetaminophen for Fever: Dr. Anders presented background. The proposal would expand the indications to include fever along with pain management and included appropriate dosing adjustments.

Proposal passed as written.

New Business:

Journal Club: Dr. Chizmar presented two articles.

- 1. Gottlieb et al. "Beta-blockade for the treatment of cardiac arrest due to ventricular fibrillation or pulseless ventricular tachycardia: A systematic review and meta-analysis." *Resuscitation* 146 (2020): 118-125.
- 2. Clemency et al. "The EMS Modified Early Warning Score (EMEWS): A Simple Count of Vital Signs as a Predictor of Out-of-Hospital Cardiac Arrests." *Prehospital Emergency Care* (2021).

Both articles will form the basis for future protocol modifications. The Gottlieb et al. article will inform our future discussion on approach to cardiac arrest patients. The Clemency et al. article has informed the proposed Crashing Patient Protocol, specifically with respect to how patients at risk of cardiac arrest or decompensation during EMS transport are identified.
