December 31, 2019, will be the last day NREMT will allow testing at the EMT-Intermediate 99 level (I99). This includes both cognitive and psychomotor examinations. Candidates testing at the I99 level must complete testing by December 31, 2019, as retest options will not be available after that date. Members suggested a thorough comparison of the AEMT and Maryland CRT levels. Members suggested an inquiry be made about adding a discussion on AEMT to the upcoming EMS Medical Directors' Symposium agenda.
