• The unit numbering process is still ongoing. The Fire side went back to previous numbering from years ago. EMS numbers have not changed yet; the EMS Subcommittee is reviewing their options.

<u>Allegany County EMS</u> – Mike Salvadge

- They have recently been approved to have 4 EMS Sergeants as an additional level of management in the department. These sergeants will basically be riding in an ambulance for now and be available to fill in when an EMS Lieutenant is not available. There will be one Sergeant for each shift.
- They have been approved for BiPAP and also RSI; are halfway through the training for RSI.

Allegany County Health Department – Allison Robinson

• They have now hired a fulltime Health Officer, Dr. Junie Delizo. He started on June 30.

Garrett College ALS Training report for Region 1 EMS Advisory Council

July 20, 2024 - 1900 hours Garrett College

<u>2022-2024 cohort</u> – The cohort is currently on summer break, but continuing to do clinical hours in the field, ER and OR. We retain 20 students and they will resume on August 30th. The last day of class will be May 7th. Graduation is set for Tuesday, May 14th at 7 pm in the Garrett College Performing Arts Conference room. The Council is invited.

<u>Accreditation</u> – Our 5-year reaccreditation is underway. We completed our self-study and have already received our Executive Analysis. Our site visit is expected in July – December of 2024.

Paramedic accelerated hybrid –Entrance testing and student interviews are complete. Acceptance letters will be going out next week. There will be 12 students in this cohort. The first session of class is Wednesday, August 30th @ 8 am. The course is a hybrid model with students doing online content, and meeting F2F on Wednesdays from 8 am-5 pm. Classroom content will be completed in July 2024. Following the capstone clinical time, graduation is expected in the first part of September 2024.

Health Sciences partnerships— The College Presidents from Garrett, Allegany, Potomac State, WVC&TC formed an allied health focus group to look at collaborating with multiple programs. A second meeting was held at Allegany on July 13th. With several programs talked about, the group will begin to push paramedics in the region and which will continue to be offered at Garrett College. The other colleges will advertise our program in their catalogs with a pathway to take GERs at the student's home institution. We are working on a seamless handoff from each institution that would make it easy for students. This work is ongoing but expected to be ready when applications open in March 2024 for the fall 2-year and hybrid programs.
