



Elite Field Background Post Settings

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Overview

Elite Field background posting is an automatic incident recovery option to ensure that Elite Field will automatically post incidents meeting certain criteria after a set amount of time, if those incidents have not yet been posted. This feature is intended to ensure that incidents get posted to your Elite Web system even if a user forgets to post and the incident does not meet the usual criteria for posting, while giving you certain workflow settings to identify and review incidents that were posted this way.

Background posting works on EMS incidents and Community Health visits.

The audit history for any incident posted using this functionality will show that the incident was posted using background posting, and will have the user who performed that action marked as ImageTrend System.

Each time a user logs in to Elite Field, Elite Field checks the device for any incidents associated with the agency that this person logged into that have not yet been posted. If any of those incidents meet the criteria set up by the admin for that agency and the device is connected to the internet, Elite Field will post those incidents and their associated attachments.

Incidents posted through background posting will automatically be assigned the incident status specified in the Background Post Incident Status field on the Elite Field Background Post Settings page.

<u>Max Number of Days Old</u> <i>Incidents that have not been posted and have not been created or updated in more than the set number of days will not be background posted.</i>	30
<u>Minimum Validation Score</u> <i>The minimum validation score that an incident must have in order to be background posted, even if they fall within the specified timeframe.</i>	[blank]
<u>Background Post Incident Status</u> <i>The incident status for any incident that is automatically posted using this functionality.</i>	Auto Posted <i>*New Status*</i>
