Documentation of Vector Change & Dual Sequential Defibrillation

Overview

Per the protocol (Section 3.4-A - Adult Ventricular Fibrillation & Pulseless Ventricular Tachycardia Algorithm), starting July 1, 2024, ALS clinicians may perform Vector Change or Dual-Sequential Defibrillation after the third shock.


Here is guidance on where and how to document this information within the eMEDS® application.

eMEDS® Documentation

The following new procedures have been added to the available list:

- Defibrillation Dual Sequential
- Defibrillation Vector Change

ALS clinicians should document each instance as either "Defibrillation - Automated (AED) - Shock" or "Defibrillation - Manual Shock". On the fourth shock, if applicable, the clinician shall use one of the two new procedures.







EMSOP Administrators Reminder
