Re: UM Capital Region Medical Center (Largo) – Opening

UM Prince George's Hospital Center (Cheverly) – Closure

Effective June 12, 2021 at 8 am, the University of Maryland Prince George's Hospital Center (Hospital Code 232) located at 3001 Hospital Drive, Cheverly, MD 20785 will permanently close to new patients.

In preparation for the movement of patients to the new hospital in Largo, UM PGHC in Cheverly will be placed on Reroute status on June 11, 2021 at 12 noon. UM PGHC in Cheverly will go on Mini-Disaster status and stop accepting any EMS patients at 12 midnight on June 12, 2021.

The University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center (Hospital Code 260) located at 901 North Harry S. Truman Drive, Largo, MD 20774 will open for new patients on June 12, 2021 at 8 am.

Please note the new hospital location and code, which has been added to eMEDS. The hospital code 232 will become inactive in the near future. UM Capital Region Medical Center will continue to provide all of the emergency and specialty services (cardiac, stroke, trauma) that were previously available at UM PGHC.
