Call to Order and Approval of Previous Minutes

The March ALS Subcommittee was called to order at 10:02 a.m. by Dr. Jeff Fillmore. A motion to approve the January 2024 minutes was made by Robby May and seconded by Colleen Lull. The minutes were approved.

Old Business

- Researching effectiveness of protocol orientation – after speaking with Luis, this project will not be moving forward at this time.
- State Content Courses update – working on developing the content. The estimate is that there will be 8 hours of content plus the protocol updates. Anticipated release date of May 1st.
- ALS Committee Roster
 - New members – Megan Barnum has been approved as a voting member of the ALS Subcommittee.
 - Updating the roster – we are still making sure that there is equal representation of all jurisdictions and education programs.

New Business

- Precepting Sites Charging Students to Precept – Dr. Chizmar proposed that the group ensure that there is evidence that this is happening now, and if it is found to be happening that the committee write a letter to SEMSAC on the issue.
- Proposal of new committee projects
 - There will be some outputs from the crisis intervention workgroup that Dr. Chizmar would like for the committee to look at after the document has been released
 - Dr. Chizmar is looking for volunteers to be on camera to deliver the content in the protocol updates
 - Dr. Chizmar is also looking for ideas on new formats to deliver the protocol updates

Announcements

- ALS renewals end April 30th – ALS clinicians are encouraged to have their applications in prior to April 15th but will still be accepted up to the 30th.

- There is an opening for a commercial ALS protocol review committee member – the posting is on the MIEMSS website. They are looking to fill this position before the May meeting
- Online Training Center Courses – known issue with a couple courses not allowing completions to go through. This is still being investigated. For courses that have been taken previously, the clinician is able to get a new certificate, but if the quiz is not also retaken then the new completion does not show up in ImageTrend.
