

PEMAC UPDATE – Jan 29, 2025
The CPS & OP Healthcare Project

- Conducted an exhibit on CPS and proper restraint use at the Mid-Maryland Emergency Nurses Association meeting on Nov 8.
- Conducted a series of trainings for newborn nursery and NICU nurses at Holy Cross/Silver Spring (Jan 14, 23, 28), and for Holy Cross/Germantown on Jan 15, and an online presentation to both hospitals on Jan 8.
- Helped teach a CPS Technician certification course at Salisbury on Nov 6- 7 for 8 students.
- Conducted a training for 6 Harford County EMS clinicians on basic CPS and the all-in-one car seat for non-emergency use, and gave them one additional Graco Slim Fit car seat.
- Conducted a training for UM Shore Regional Health at Easton's newborn nursery staff, and gave them car seats to distribute to families in emergencies.
- Worked with MD KISS, JHCC and other safety advocates to update educational resources on foreign and counterfeit car seats, which are becoming more common among parents as they order car seats online.
- Assisted at one seat check or distribution event. (SK-Baltimore on 12/6).
- Started planning a new webinar on pregnant women and their fetuses in motor vehicle crashes that will include recommendations for safely traveling in cars.
- Continued to promote and distribute the new handout on booster seats and 11 x 17" poster, with deliveries to pediatricians' offices around the state.
- Continued to provide car seats for needy families. Distributed 36 car seats to 8 agencies. Receiving agencies are primarily mother-baby units in hospitals, but also EDs, NICUs and Safe Kids-Maryland partners.
- Continued assisting with the Mile One Cares car seat distribution project along with MD Kids in Safety Seats.
- Started writing a proposal to the Maryland Highway Safety Office to fund this project for FY26.
