## Protocol Development & Development of training priorities 2026 New protocols for discussion: (July 26 implementation)

- All are welcome
- 1. NEW: Critically Unstable Patient for all ages that expands the current Protocol 2.4 to include all ages: Committee proposed rewording the BLS section, linking to the head injury criteria in Protocol 8.4, and discussed at length the language to capture when to stay on scene and when lifesaveing airway needs required rapid transport. Future discussion at August PEMAC protocol meeting on 8/20.
- 2. Norepinephrine infusion OSP revisions for pediatric [15.20]. Committee recommended specific guidelines for Pediatric TBI be included in protocol 8.4-P. Separate documentation for Sepsis protocol 4.14P.
- **3.** Ketamine pharmacology Medical control required for 5-12 yoa will be included as an administrative update for consistency.
- 4. Seizure 4.13-P with updated language for second dose of medications and when medical control is needed. Committee recommended if no benzodiazepines have been give prior to arrival (parent rescue med), a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose may be given without medical control for ongoing seizures. But not if seizures have stopped. If home dose has been given, then 1<sup>st</sup> does may be given and medical control is required for what will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose to that patients. Concern is to ensure ventilator effort is not suppressed and that no dose are give to prevent seizures from restarting.
- 5. Newly Born Resuscitation align ALS sequencing and language to BLS. The new draft presented incorporates the BLS and ALS into one algorithm with BLS at top and ALS to follow. Notes from page 125 (2025 edition) would be incorporated and the APGAR score kept in place. The inverted Triangle has been a great teaching tool and can remain for scenarios. It was dropped from the 2020 ILCOR/AHA documents. The 2025 ILCOR/AHA/AAP Newly born resuscitation will be released in October and 9<sup>th</sup> edition of NRP released. These changes will be cross walked with those documents before finalization.

All proposals for 2026 must be submitted prior to June 11, 2025 (Wednesday) for discussion at July 2, 2025 PEMAC meeting.

# PEMAC UPDATE – July 2, 2025 The CPS & OP Healthcare Project

- Helped teach 2 days of the Child Passenger Safety Technician certification course in LaPlata to 8 students.
- Helped conduct a display on CPS and pediatric vehicular heatstroke for Safe Kids Baltimore/UMMC at the "Stop the Bleed" Day on May 22nd at Martin State Airport. About 600 high school kids attended.
- Helped conduct a display on child passenger safety at Univ MD Medical Center on may 28 along with Safe Kids-Baltimore.
- Conducted an interactive display/game on CPS (as well as the PVH temperature display) at the MD State Firefighter's Convention, June 15-17, reaching about 750 people.
- Coordinated a webinar, "Bump Ahead: Ensuring Maternal and Fetal Safety on the Road" on May 6. 103 attended. (nurses, EMS and CPSTs; most desired CEUs). Evaluations were very positive. Webinar is archived at <a href="https://www.miemss.org/home/emsc/cps">www.miemss.org/home/emsc/cps</a> and CEUs are still available.
- Conducted a training for nurses in MCH, ED and peds at the Adventist White Oak Medical Center on June 24. About 30 attended and they received car seats to start their participation in our emergency car seat program.
- Helped at a car seat check and distribution event at Mt Washington Pediatric Hospital on June 6<sup>th</sup>. Senior-checked one CPST and checked 3 cars/3 families.
- Helped at a car seat check event at the Salisbury Fire Dept on June 18.
- Lent MIEMSS' two outdoor temperature displays educating on pediatric vehicular heatstroke four times since the last PEMAC meeting. Several reservations were cancelled or rescheduled due to rain.
- Continued to provide car seats for needy families, giving out 25 car seats to 7 different hospitals (9 departments). Receiving agencies are primarily mother-baby units in hospitals, but also EDs, NICUs, Peds, and Safe Kids-Maryland partners.

## Child Passenger Safety Update-Summer 2025

- 1) A lot of non-approved car seats are being purchased and used by caregivers. They buy these mostly through online vendors who sell "knock-off" seats at a great discount, but the seats don't meet U.S. federal safety standards and may not be safe. Some seats meet foreign regulations, but not the U.S. standards. See attached handout (in English and Spanish) to help identify approved vs non-approved seats. - 2) As of June 1<sup>st</sup>, four children in the U.S. have died from **Pediatric Vehicular Heatstroke**. One of these recent cases occurred in Silver Spring where a parent forgot the child was in the car.
