The *Maryland Medical Protocols for Emergency Medical Services* (2023 edition) is now available on the MIEMSS website (<a href="https://www.miemss.org/home/ems-providers/protocols">https://www.miemss.org/home/ems-providers/protocols</a>). The protocols will go into effect on <a href="July 1, 2023">July 1, 2023</a>.
