Garrett College ALS Training report for Region 1 EMS Advisory Council

July 18, 2024 - 1900 hours Garrett College

<u>2022-2024 cohort</u> – This 2-year cohort was completed on May 7th. NREMT psychomotor occurred on May 18th. 15 students tested with 14 passing. One student had to retest at another location and passed. The written exam was scheduled on several other dates. To date, 10 students have passed the NRP written with the others working on retesting.

<u>Paramedic accelerated hybrid</u> —This 1-year cohort has 9 students. They completed the classroom part of the course on July 10th and started their Capstone. This is at least 100 hours in the field and 20 ALS calls. Following the capstone, students will be able to schedule their NRP exam ASAP since there is no longer a psychomotor exam. Graduation is on September 16, 2024, at the Garrett College Performing Arts Center. The council is invited.

<u>Fall 2024 cohort</u> – Applications for the 2024-2026 two-year evening program, and the 2024-2025 daytime hybrid program have closed. We have been doing entrance testing and student interviews. Students will be notified at the beginning of August for acceptance with classes beginning in September.

<u>Accreditation</u> – Our 5-year reaccreditation is underway. We completed our self-study and have already received our Executive Analysis. Our site visit has been confirmed for December 9 and 10, 2024. This will also be a virtual site visit.
