The 2020 *Maryland Medical Protocols for EMS* are now available on the MIEMSS website (<a href="http://www.miemss.org/home/ems-providers/protocols">http://www.miemss.org/home/ems-providers/protocols</a>).

Please ensure that you are referencing the protocols labeled with a release date of "6/10/2020" on the bottom of each page. A few revisions were required as noted below. If you downloaded the protocols or spreadsheet prior to 6/10/2020, please disregard and delete those documents. Of note, the necessary revisions have been incorporated into all printed materials that will be forthcoming from MIEMSS.

A revision was made to the dosing in mL/min for the pediatric epinephrine infusion chart. Also, a small clarification was made to the BLS epinephrine pharmacology pages to maintain consistency with the Asthma/COPD protocol.

In addition, I have received inquiries regarding the 100 mL bag for epinephrine infusions. The switch from a 1000 mL to a 100 mL bag for the epinephrine infusion was made intentionally in order to limit the amount of volume infused for volume-sensitive populations (e.g. cardiogenic shock and pediatric patients). The 100 mL bag used as a diluent for the epinephrine infusion may be LR, NS or D5W.
